



BLAKELEY

The Blakeley Addition Tract in Baldwin County consists of 420 acres of upland pine-hardwoods and bottomland hardwood forests on hilly land at the edge of the Mobile Delta marshlands.

In addition to the wild, undeveloped landscape there are also many historical features to enjoy and recreational opportunities, such as hiking, camping and wildlife observation, to take advantage of.

The land in this area was used by prehistoric Indian societies, European pioneers, early American settlers, Civil War soldiers and generations of early farmers.

Directions:

From Mobile, take I-10 Exit 30 to US 31N (Battleship Parkway). After crossing Mobile Bay, turn left onto AL-225 and go 4 1/2 miles. Historic Blakeley State Park is on the left.

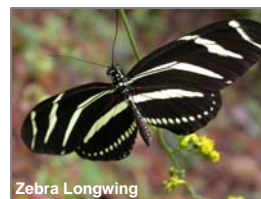
