



RUFFNER MOUNTAIN

The Ruffner Mountain Addition in Jefferson County consists of 227 acres of mountainous pine-upland hardwood forest land contiguous to the grounds and facilities of the Ruffner Mountain Nature Center. This tract, surrounded by the densely populated greater Birmingham metro area, provides tremendous opportunities for environmental education and outdoor recreation, such as hiking and wildlife observation.

Directions:

From Birmingham, take Interstate I-59, North or South bound, to Exit 132 at First Avenue North. At the end of the exit ramp, bear to the right onto 1st Ave. Go to the first traffic light at 83rd Street and take a right. Continue onto Rugby Ave. Turn left at 81st Street South. Ruffner Mountain Nature Center is located at the end of the street.
