Job II-A: Kill Studies of Deer on Alabama Wildlife Management Areas

Study Leader: Christopher W. Cook

Objective: To measure, record, and evaluate the deer harvest on Alabama Wildlife Management Areas.

Procedures: Project personnel recorded hunter participation and success on each of the 31 wildlife management areas (WMAs) and 17 physically disabled hunting areas (PDHAs) having deer hunting during the 2009-10 season. For reporting purposes, Black Warrior – Zone A, Black Warrior – Zone B, Upper Delta – Zone A, and Upper Delta – Zone B are considered separate WMAs. The Jackson County Waterfowl Areas are considered a single WMA, as are Swan Creek & Mallard-Fox Creek WMAs and W. L. Holland & Mobile-Tensaw Delta WMAs. Deer were examined and records were made of their sex, age, weight, and antler development when possible. Portions of this information were compiled and computed by project cooperators and submitted to the project leader for further analysis.

Discussion:

Hunter Participation and Success:

The number of deer killed on each WMA, the hunting method, and the man-days of participation are compared in Table I. The figures in Tables I through X are considered estimates since season permits are issued on many of the areas. Hunter participation and success can vary due to weather, date of hunt, and length of the season. To better understand overall trends, Table II and Tables V through VIII compare this past season's participation and success with an average of prior years, as well as last year, only for the WMAs offering deer hunting during the 2009-10 hunting season.

Participation in stalk hunts on the WMAs that offered stalk hunts during the 2009-10 hunting season was slightly below last year's totals. Nineteen of the 28 WMAs offering stalk hunts this

season had decreases in hunter man-days for stalk hunts. Average man-days hunted per deer killed increased from 16.0 in 2008-09 to 17.3 in 2009-10. This success rate still was better than the average of 18.6 man-days per deer killed for the period of 2003-08 on these same WMAs (Table II).

Twenty WMAs scheduled either-sex deer hunts for youth hunters during the 2009-10 hunting season. Each hunter participating on one of these special hunts had to be less than 16 years of age and had to be accompanied by a non-hunting, licensed adult 25 years of age or older, or a parent. Total participation on these hunts decreased from last year's total of 1,015 youth hunters to 744 youth hunters for 2009-10. The number of deer killed on these hunts also decreased from 182 in 2008-09 to 74 for 2009-10. These totals (hunters and deer killed) are included in the stalk hunt totals in the following tables. The numbers also are shown in Table III. The primary cause of the decreased participation and deer kill was the cancellation of two hunts on the Fred T. Stimpson area due to high river levels. The primary purpose of the youth hunts is to acquaint young hunters with deer hunting. These hunts will continue on WMAs where there is sufficient interest.

Twenty-three WMAs offered a total of 218 days of either-sex gun deer hunts (Table IV). Two hundred fourteen days of the 218 days of hunter's choice hunts were stalk hunt days. The remaining four days were dog hunt days. All of the either-sex gun hunts for the 2009-10 hunting season offered 100% either-sex opportunities. The chance to kill antlerless deer on the either-sex hunts greatly influences the hunter participation, number of deer killed, and hunter success levels shown in the stalk hunt totals (Tables I and II). Participation in either-sex stalk hunts was 72% of the total stalk hunt hunting effort and represented 75% of the total stalk hunt deer kill. The four days of either-sex dog hunts were 38% of the total dog hunt hunting effort and represented 68% of the total dog hunt deer kill. The hunter success rate for either-sex stalk hunts was one deer per 16.5 man-days of hunter effort, which was much higher than the success rate for the bucks only stalk hunts (one deer per 19.6 man-days of effort). The hunter success rate for either-sex dog hunts was one deer per 11.1 man-days of hunter effort, which also was much higher than the success rate for the bucks only dog hunts (one deer per 39.0 man-days of effort). Fifty-two percent of the deer killed on the hunter's choice hunts were antlerless deer.

Participation in managed dog hunts increased from the 2008-09 totals (Table V). Hunter success was lower this year, going from 17.9 man-days of hunting per deer killed in 2008-09 to 20.0 man-days per deer killed in 2009-10. Hunter success was higher than the 2003-08 average of 24.3 man-days per deer killed. Dog hunting participation was 7.0% of the total deer hunting effort on WMAs during the 2009-10 season and accounted for 5.9% of the total deer kill.

Archery hunting participation decreased slightly in 2009-10, declining by nearly 1,100 man-days from the 2008-09 hunting season totals (Table VI). Hunter success also declined slightly, going from 16.4 man-days per deer killed during the 2008-09 hunting season to 16.7 man-days per deer killed during the 2009-10 season (Table VI). The success rate for 2009-10 was higher than the 2003-08 average of 20.5 man-days per deer killed. Archery hunting continues to provide a large portion of the deer hunting recreation on WMAs, representing 26.6% of the total deer hunting effort and 26.6% of the total deer kill.

Participation in primitive weapons (PW) hunts on the nineteen WMAs offering PW hunts during the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons decreased from 4,448 man-days of hunting to 3,980 man-days of hunting. The success rate on PW hunts improved, going from 12.9 man-days per deer killed during the 2008-09 season to 10.1 man-days per deer killed for 2009-10 (Table VII). Participation on PW hunts represented 5.0% of the total deer hunting effort and 8.3% of the total deer killed on WMAs during the 2009-10 season.

The total hunting effort on the WMAs offering deer hunting during the 2009-10 seasons, as shown in Table VIII, dropped by 4.2% (i.e., 3,468 man-days) when compared to totals from the 2008-09 hunting season. This year's hunting effort was over 6,600 man-days below the average of the previous five years (2003-04 through 2007-08) for these same WMAs. This year's hunter success ratio of one deer killed per 16.7 man-days of effort for all deer hunts was higher than last year's (17.0 man-days per deer killed) and the average for the previous five seasons (19.3 man-days per deer killed) on these WMAs.

Hunting Pressure and Kill Per Square Mile:

Total man-days of deer hunting per square mile, as shown in Table IX, was highest on St. Clair, Little River, Geneva State Forest, Lowndes, Frank W. & Rob M. Boykin, Blue Spring, Barbour,

Riverton, David K. Nelson, and James D. Martin-Skyline WMAs, respectively. Total man-days of hunting per square mile was lowest on Fred T. Stimpson (youth only hunts), Seven-Mile Island (archery only), Upper Delta – Zone B, W. L. Holland & Mobile-Tensaw Delta, Choccolocco, Upper Delta – Zone A, Black Warrior – Zone A, the Jackson County Waterfowl Areas (archery only), Black Warrior – Zone B, and Swan Creek & Mallard-Fox Creek (archery only) WMAs, respectively. Stalk hunting made up the largest portion of total use per square mile on most areas (22 of 31). Archery hunts made up the largest portion of use per square mile on Geneva State Forest, the Jackson County Waterfowl Areas (archery only), Seven-Mile Island (archery only), Swan Creek & Mallard-Fox Creek (archery only), and Upper Delta – Zone A WMAs. Dog hunts made up the largest portion of use on Blue Spring, Frank W. & Rob M. Boykin, Scotch, and Upper Delta – Zone B WMAs.

Most areas of Alabama can support a balanced deer kill (bucks and does) of ten or more deer per square mile annually, depending on habitat quality. Only two WMAs achieved this level during the 2009-10 hunting season, mainly because of the limited amount of hunting pressure on most WMAs (Table X). St. Clair WMA had the highest estimated number of deer killed per square mile (20.49), followed by Blue Spring (11.44), Lowndes (9.79), and David K. Nelson (9.20) WMAs. W. L. Holland & Mobile-Tensaw Delta WMAs had the lowest estimated number of deer killed per square mile (0.44), followed by Upper Delta – Zone B (0.65), Upper Delta – Zone A (1.06), Black Warrior – Zone B (1.32), Swan Creek & Mallard-Fox Creek (1.64), Black Warrior – Zone A (1.74), the Jackson County Waterfowl Areas (1.78), Seven-Mile Island (2.01), and Fred T. Stimpson (2.27) WMAs.

Weights and Condition of Deer:

Average weights of deer within specific age classes are one of the best indicators of overall herd condition (Table XI). An average live weight under 95 pounds for 1-½ year old males (i.e., yearlings) can be an indicator of poor physical condition caused by insufficient nutrition, either from poor habitat, heavy competition for food from other deer, or both. Where the yearling males have an average body weight of 95 to 105 pounds on areas with good soils, there should be concern the deer population exceeds the capacity of the land to support the herd in good condition. The deer population should be reduced to a more healthy level in any situation where

competition for food is the cause of low body weights in deer. Areas in Alabama with yearling males averaging above 110 pounds live weight usually are not carrying an excess of deer and efforts should be made to keep those populations at current levels. Average yearling male body weights among all WMAs averaged 103 pounds for the 2009-10 hunting season, which is slightly lower than the average for the 2008-09 season (104 pounds). Swan Creek & Mallard-Fox Creek (120 pounds), Black Warrior – Zone A (115 pounds), Wolf Creek (115 pounds), James D. Martin-Skyline (112 pounds), Barbour (111 pounds), and Lowndes (111 pounds) WMAs reported average yearling male body weights that exceeded 110 pounds. Ten other WMAs reported average yearling male body weights between 100 and 110 pounds. Fred T. Stimpson (76 pounds), Choccolocco (86 pounds), Perdido River (86 pounds), Oakmulgee (92 pounds), Scotch (93 pounds), Frank W. & Rob M. Boykin (96 pounds), and the Jackson County Waterfowl Areas (96 pounds) had average yearling male body weights less than 100 pounds.

Antler Development:

Antler development (i.e., number of antler points, antler base circumference, main antler beam length, and inside antler spread) for all age classes of bucks was very good on some areas, such as Barbour, Black Warrior – Zones A & B, Cahaba River, Coosa, Freedom Hills, Geneva State Forest, Hollins, Lauderdale, Lowndes, Mulberry Fork, Sam R. Murphy, and Wolf Creek, but remains poor on others (Tables XII and XIII). In most situations, a high percentage of spikes in the yearling age class and a significant occurrence of spikes in the older age classes are a reflection of poor habitat conditions and/or an overcrowded population. The heavy harvest of yearling bucks on some WMAs prevents significant numbers of bucks from reaching the older age classes. This alone continues to limit the harvest of bucks 2-½ years old and older on these WMAs. Corrections to both nutritional deficiencies and buck age structure are necessary in order to bring about improvements in the quality of bucks harvested. However, on areas with poor soil fertility and/or habitat quality, reducing competition for food by reducing deer populations may require the removal of more deer than may be acceptable to many WMA hunters. On very poor quality sites, even a significant reduction in deer numbers may not produce improvements in deer quality. For this reason, some areas may not be suited for this type of management.

Six WMAs were under quality deer management (QDM) guidelines for the 2009-10 hunting season. These included Barbour (11 seasons), Black Warrior – Zone B (3 seasons), Freedom Hills (8 seasons), Geneva State Forest (10 seasons), Lauderdale (8 seasons), and Lowndes (7 seasons) WMAs. Bucks must have at least 4-points on one antler to be legal for harvest on Black Warrior – Zone B. Bucks must have at least 3-points on one antler to be legal for harvest on the other five areas. Hunters also have more opportunity to kill antlerless deer on gun deer hunts on these WMAs than is available on most other WMAs. All six WMAs managed using QDM guidelines have shown improvements in the age structure of the antlered buck harvest since initiation of the QDM programs, with Barbour, Freedom Hills, Geneva State Forest, Lauderdale, and Lowndes WMAs showing the most improvement. This was the primary reason for implementing the antler restrictions on these areas. Prior to the implementation of the antler restrictions, 1-½ year olds were the largest single age class in the annual buck harvest on all of the current QDM areas. For the 2009-10 hunting season, the overwhelming majority of the reported antlered buck harvest on these areas was comprised of 2-½ years old and older deer (Barbour 77%, Black Warrior – Zone B 88%, Freedom Hills 91%, Geneva State Forest 88%, Lauderdale 93%, Lowndes 91%). The current management strategies on all six areas also should produce a higher percentage of adult bucks (2-½ years old and older) in the population, as well as a more balanced adult sex ratio, more intense rutting behavior, and many other traits characteristic of a healthy, balanced deer herd managed under QDM guidelines. Biologists on these areas will continue to collect biological data, as well as public opinion data, to monitor the status of the deer herd and the hunters using these six WMAs. These data are used to evaluate the effectiveness of current management practices used on the areas and aid biologists in making decisions to help achieve their long-term management objectives. As the public's demand for more WMAs managed for better quality deer becomes stronger, the Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries may decide to initiate QDM programs on other public hunting areas in the future. The majority of Alabama's WMAs will continue to be managed for maximum opportunity for buck harvest until that time.

Physically Disabled Hunting Areas:

Alabama's Physically Disabled Hunting Trail is a network of public and private recreational sites throughout the state providing accessible deer hunting opportunities for individuals with physical disabilities. The trail has been developed by the Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources in cooperation with a broad range of sponsors. The seventeen PDHAs open for deer hunting by physically disabled hunters during the 2009-10 hunting season provided 846 man-days of deer hunting opportunity, which was less than the 2008-09 hunting season (981 man-days). Hunters killed 71 deer (33 bucks and 41 does) on these areas. Hunters killed one deer for every 11.9 man-days of hunting effort expended, which was lower than last year's success rate of 10.4 man-days of hunting effort per deer killed. The number of man-days of hunting effort expended, number of deer killed, and hunter success rates are summarized in Table XV.

Remarks:

Wildlife management areas provide a significant portion of the deer hunting opportunity in Alabama. This year a 50.7% sample of the total deer harvest on WMAs was used in Tables XI, XII, and XIII. Project cooperators entered check station data on age, sex, weight, and antler development on bucks harvested from WMAs on computer and submitted a copy of these data to the project leader for analysis. Table XIV represents the number of male and female deer by age class used in the 50.7% sample collected from the various management areas. WMA totals, District totals, Statewide totals, and individual hunt results are listed in Appendices I, II, and III. Efforts to improve the accuracy of the tables and to expand our survey will continue when necessary to better manage the resource.
